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## Who Should Attend

Partners in Pediatric Care (PIPC) is a course designed to be of interest to physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, nurses, residents, and other healthcare professionals involved in primary, specialty, and acute care for children with acute or chronic conditions. After this activity, participants will be able to utilize new assessment modalities and interventions for the care of infants, children, and adolescents.

## Objectives

- Identify strategies in mental health care related to the mental health of patient parents, youth with depression and/or anxiety, and for pediatric transplant patients.
